II. Three Biblical Judgements

1. The judgement of Christians at the rapture, when they go to "the judgment seat of Christ" 2 Cor. 5:10 and receive their reward.
2. The judgement of the nations Mt. 25:31-46 seven years later at the end of the tribulation and Armageddon.

3. The final judgement of all the lost from the Old and New Testament eras, the tribulation, and the millennium.

Biblical Names for Hell

- Sheol (O.T. place of the dead)
- Hades (N.T. version of Sheol)
- Tartarus (place of holding for angels, Jude 6 and 2 Peter 2:4)
- Gehenna (lake of fire and final punishment)
